OVERVIEW	Students explore the ways in which aspects and concerns of texts from the past have been carried forward, borrowed from and/or appropriated into more recent culture and explores how and why cultural values are maintained and changed. The module begins by exploring a range of texts and appropriations. A detailed study of Charlotte Bronte’s novel <i>Jane Eyre</i> follows. Students will also be introduced to research methodology to begin their Related project – 1 period a cycle commencing in Week 3.

Students realise insights into their research and personal evaluation of the texts in an analytical multimodal presentation.
