OVERVIEW	Students will study the tragedy, Macbeth, exploring notions of tragic structure and exploring the consequences of disruption to power and the laws of society. Students will revisit essay writing and complete a timed, in-class essay.					Students will study the class novel, The Great Gatsby, with a focus on the way Fitzgerald explores how contextual values can be show to be disrupted in literature. The idea of The Great American Dream is challenged in this text and students will explore why and how this disruption occurs.
