OVERALL TOPIC	UOI 3 - Poetry UOI 4 - Memoir										
Overview	Students will read a range of poems where a strong personal voice has been crafted for purpose. Students will commence with an investigation of the dramatic monologue as a poetic form and how it can be used in powerful ways. Students will then craft their own piece where they take on the person of a figure (real or imagined) who is unwittingly revealing aspects of themselves. Students will record themselves delivering their poem and provide an analysis of intent for assessment purposes.					Students will read and investigate Amy Thurig's memoir, Tell Me Again. Thurig is a Darug woman who writes about her experiences and life, ultimately championing love and family. Students will analyse the structural features of the text and the role of storytelling in a non-fiction work. Students will engage in their own personal memoir writing throughout the unit.
