# Uniform Expectations Policy

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## Purpose

The purpose of this policy is to set the School's requirements for school uniforms. It is an expectation that all students uphold the School's reputation and standards by adhering to the uniform expectations.

The wearing of a school uniform promotes a sense of belonging for students and creates a positive identity for the school community. School uniforms contribute to the personal safety of students by allowing easier recognition of students inside the school and in the community.

## Guidelines

- The School uniform should be worn correctly at all times, while on campus and within the wider community.
- Summer uniform will be worn in Terms 1 and 4.
- Winter uniform will be worn in Term 2 and 3.
- All students have the option of wearing shorts in summer and trousers in winter.
- For Senior Students – shorts are not to be worn for Formal occasions – trousers/skirt and blazer only. Formal occasions include Graduation, Leadership Assembly, and Annual Presentation of Awards. This applies to all students attending these events.
- **All students K-12 are required to have a sports uniform which is to be worn for sporting events, carnivals and may be required on school excursions.**

# Travelling to and from School

It is compulsory for all students to wear full school uniform to and from school. In Terms 2 and 3 this includes wearing the blazer.

The only exceptions are outlined below.

- Junior School students may wear their sports uniform to and from school on days when they have sport or PDHPE only. If students have before or after school co-curricular and it is not a day when they wear sports uniform they must change into their uniform for the School day. School tracksuit pants are optional in Terms 2 and 3.
- Senior School | If a student arrives at school by car or on a Hills Grammar private bus service, they may wear the sports uniform if they have sports training or a practical PE class in Period 1. However, they must then change into the correct school uniform. Similarly, sports uniform may be worn if departing the school by car or Hills Grammar private bus service, if the student has a practical PE class in Period 5.
- Students traveling on all other forms of transport must travel in their school uniform.

## Appearance

- The uniform is to be clean and in good repair.
- All items should be marked with the student's name.
- The School blazer is to be worn at all formal occasions all year round – including assemblies, formal presentations, events etc.
- In Junior School, hats are to be worn during play time. Senior students are encouraged to wear hats when outdoors.
- The length of the skirts/dresses should, for Senior School reach the top of the student's knee cap and for Junior School sit on the knee.
- The School rain jacket is only to be worn when it is raining. It cannot be worn in place of a blazer or School red jumper.
- Students are to wear the entire School or sports uniform at any one time (not a combination of both).
- **All students K-12 are required to have a sports uniform which is to be worn for sporting events, carnivals and may be required on school excursions.**
- Other items such as hoodies, scarves or items that have not been purchased from the uniform shop, etc, are not permitted.
- Any clothing worn under the school uniform is not to be visible.
- School shoes should be traditional black, leather school shoes (*K-2 lace up, Buckle or Velcro, 3-12 Lace up only*). Black sneakers / Air Force 1, Doc Martin's or other styles of black sports shoes **are not** an acceptable substitute for leather school shoes. Shoes are to be clean and polished.
- In Junior School, sports shoes should be white or black. No other coloured sports shoe is acceptable. In Senior School sports shoes should be fit for purpose. Street wear such as Air Force 1, Dunks, Samba's etc are not permitted.
- Items purchased for specific events (includes bags, t-shirts, jumpers etc), such as overseas tours, are not to be worn at school as part of normal school uniform.
- Year 6 T-shirts may be worn with the sports uniform only and only on the days when sports uniform is required.

Year 12 jerseys can be worn as part of the School uniform once acquired. **School shirts and ties must be worn underneath the jersey at all times.** Year 12 jerseys are not to be worn for Formal occasions. Formal occasions include Graduation, Leadership Assembly, and Annual Presentation of Awards.

## Hair and Make-up

- **Visible make-up** – eg blush, mascara, eyeliner, false eyelashes – **is not permitted**. Senior School students are permitted to wear concealer or tinted SPF cream.
- Nails should be kept clean and short. Coloured nail polish and imitation / acrylic nails **are not permitted**.
- Students' hair is to be their natural colour and appearance – dyed or highlighted hair **is not permitted**.
- Hair should be conservative in style and neatly groomed at all times.
- **For boys**
  - Must be cleanly shaven unless special dispensation has been granted for cultural / religious reasons.
  - Hair should be off the collar, not hang over the eyes or ears, no ponytails or undercuts.
  - Hair should not be shaved shorter than a Number 2.
- **For girls**
  - Hair ties and accessories should be plain, and any hair accessories used should be in line with the items available from the uniform shop.
  - Senior School: It is preferable for hair to be completely tied back, however, a "half up" style may be worn as long as hair is pulled away from the face.
  - Junior School: If hair touches the top of the shoulders, it should be completely tied back.

## Jewellery

- As a general rule, jewellery may not be worn.
- Girls are permitted to wear one small plain single stud, or sleepers, in the lobe of each ear.
- Boys are not permitted to wear earrings.
- Necklaces may not be worn on the outside of the School uniform.
- Rings and bracelets are not permitted.
- Facial piercings are not permitted.
- Jewellery that has specific religious significance may be worn if permission is sought from the school.
- Senior School | Small clear retainers may be worn.

## School bags

- School backpacks, Hills Grammar branded canvas bags, and School sports bags are the only bags permitted, including when going on an excursion.
- For excursions, Junior School students may use their library bags.

## Excursions

- Full School or sports uniform is to be worn on all excursions unless explicitly specified by the organising teacher. Students will not be permitted to attend excursions unless in full uniform.

# Badges

School badges symbolise an achievement or leadership position attained by a student. They are to be worn with pride as recognition of their role or achievement.

Students are permitted to wear only School issued badges. Badges issued for a leadership position or the attainment of an achievement should only be worn for the year of service. Once the year of service has concluded, the badge should be removed and can be retained as a keepsake. Badges issued could include:

- House badges – can be worn at all times
- Leadership position badges for roles currently being served eg House Captain, Co-Curricular Leader, SRC etc - can be worn during the year the student holds this position and then retained as a keepsake.
- Hills Passport badges – NB if you have obtained the silver badge, the bronze badge should be removed etc and retained as a keepsake.
- Rise badge – one can be worn at all times.
- Poet Laureate – worn during the year the student holds this position and then retained as a keepsake.
- Peer support – This badge is issued as a recognition of a student's training and service as a peer support leader and may be worn at all times.
- Da Vinci Decathlon / other special school badges – Only one to be worn at a time for the year of the activity and then removed and retained as a keepsake.
- Year 12 Badge – Issued as they commence Year 12 and can be worn at all times throughout Year 12.
- Music badges – can be worn during the timeframe that the student is in the ensemble/choir/group. When they advance to the next level, the previous badge must be removed and retained as a keepsake.
- Charity/ fundraising / special event badges may be worn for the day of the event and the following 2 weeks only before being removed.
- Badges should be worn on the left-hand side of the school blazer only.

## On occasions when uniform is not required

- On occasions when School uniform is not required, e.g., some excursions, 'muffi' days – the clothing worn must be appropriate for school activities. For example, the following are not permitted thongs, sandals, Ugg boots, pyjamas, bare midriffs, very short skirts, very short shorts, sleeveless t-shirts.
- Uniform Pass | On the rare occasions when School uniform is not able to be worn, a note of explanation from a parent or guardian is required and students should provide this note to their Junior School Class Teacher / Head of Year. Senior School students will be issued with a uniform pass.
- The expectations around uniforms are at the discretion of the Heads of School.



# Uniform Guidelines

These guidelines are to be read in conjunction with the **Uniform Expectations Policy**.

All items of uniform must be clearly labelled with the name of the student

# Sports Uniform Guidelines

## Netball, Football, Futsal, Basketball, Equestrian & Fencing

All tops/ shirts / jerseys are provided by the School for the season or duration of the competition

Students will be required to purchase shorts and socks as required from the Uniform Shop

Items will vary across each sport and students will be advised of specific requirements at the commencement of the season

## Commemorative Wear

From time to time staff may wish to organise items of uniform for students and staff involved in particular programs – e.g. School Musicals, Tours, Australian Business Week – such purchases must be pre-approved, designed and then supplied via Bob Stewart and distribution arranged by school staff.

## Supporter Wear

A selection of clothing items is available for purchase by parents and supporters of the School from the Uniform Shop

## Merchandise

A selection of School crested merchandise is available for purchase by staff, parents and supporters from the Uniform Shop

## Sport Coaches

All sports coaches will be provided with a School PE shirt, jacket and a hat – such purchases must be preapproved, designed and then supplied via Bob Stewart and distribution arranged by school staff.
